## Eligibility and requirements

The second level postgraduate **Master in Piano Performance** (60 ECTS - complying with EQ8 in the European Qualifications Framework), organized by Conservatorio Guido Cantelli in Novara (Italy), is directed to students with a second level Academic Diploma or a Master Degree (EQ7 in the EQF) and to those in possession of an Italian Conservatory Diploma (the old "Diploma di Vecchio Ordinamento"), or an equivalent degree.

Non-EU students must provide a declaration of validity and - where requested - an official translation of the certificate of study.

## **Admission process**

Due to the COVID-19 emergency, selection will be made through online procedure only. Students will be asked to send a good quality video through cloud systems, or uploading it on the ISIDATA platform (details will be provided). Repertoire must include at least 30 minutes of music of candidate's choice from solo piano repertoire.

#### **Fees**

The tuition fee for the 2021/2022 Master of Arts in Piano Performance is established in Euro 3500,00, payable in installments. A conspicuous number of Scholarships from Regione Piemonte will be awarded to students. More details will be provided when available.

The program aims to offer a wide range of learning opportunities for high standard students with distinguished personalities of the music world. Individual lessons will be given by an in-residence Faculty (both in Piano and Chamber Music), paired with a series of Masterclasses held by leading artists and teachers.
