

SWING - a project to blend technology, innovative teaching methods and enhanced collaboration, tailoring technical development upon students and teachers needs and input – HYBRID workshop

Thursday 4th November, 9:30 – 13:30 CET, Room 162 and online

After 3 years of work, the [SWING project](#) will present its result at the AEC Congress 2021 in Antwerp:

- an enhanced and tailored set of technical tools for long distance learning and performing with low latency, centered around the LoLa system <https://lola.conts.it>;
- learning and "how to" guides to help using this technology but not limited to it;
- experiences of many students and teachers who worked in "remote mobility" during their regular academic year, exchanging knowledge, learning the technology, creating new ways of working together
- findings from the interviews of all involved people, which show also how the impact of Covid-19 pandemic affected the world of higher musical education.

The workshop will feature a live demonstration of a lesson happening in Vienna, Trieste and Ljubljana: we will jump into the middle of one of the SWING long distance real teaching sessions, to see how it works. Participants in Antwerp will be able to ask questions and interact with students and teachers involved in the demonstration, and possibly get involved also in remote students evaluation.

Ideas for future possible activities using the LoLa technologies and possible collaborations and partnerships in the framework of the new Erasmus+ blended possibilities will be also discussed.
