- The (EMU) is the European umbrella organisation of national music school associations in Europe.
- At present, national music school associations from 26 European countries are members of the EMU, representing more than 6.000 music schools, 150.000 teachers and over 4.000.000 pupils/student.
- Activities include capacity building, information exchange & networking, collecting and publishing statistics, advocacy & lobbying activities and organising European youth music festival.
- The EMU's organisation includes the General Assembly, the Presidium and the General Secretariat, which is located in Berlin, Germany.
