Nearest Metro:

Forum Metro station on Rosenørns Alle – across the Academy.

M1 and M2 line (1 min walk to RDAM).

Airport and Connections to Central Copenhagen and RDAM

- **Metro**

M2 line connects you directly to both central Copenhagen and RDAM

Transport time: 15 mins. and 19 mins.

- **Train**

Øresundstog (regional train)

You can take the train to Nørreport station in central Copenhagen.

Transport time: 17 mins.

From Nørreport station, you can take M1 or M2 (terminating at Vanløse) to RDAM.

We would strongly suggest the metro, as goes every 4 minutes and is more convenient.

Bus lines:

Bus numbers 2A and 71 stop outside of the Danish Royal Academy of Music.

Bus 1A stops approx. 100 meters away at H. C. Ørsted's Vej

Bikes:

Copenhagen is ranked as the world's most bike-friendly city.

The Royal Danish Academy of Music has designated parking for 130 bikes.

There are several bike rentals around the city.

Bycyklen.dk docking station can be found just across the Academy.

Car Parking:

There are several options for parking in the area, which forms part of both the Frederiksberg and City of Copenhagen municipal parking zones.
