



Can She Play? - A talk about representation and sustainability in the music industry

Co-founding member of community SheCanPlay and MD of Warner Music Denmark Karen Vincent aim in this talk to explore issues involved in the music industry regarding gender balance and representation. She will give you an insight in how they work in SheCanPlay, what the female and gender minorities in the project sees as their opportunities and their barriers. And give an overview of the results of the last seven years working with this.

She will also look into the mechanisms in play in the many different aspects of a music career; from music schools to label and gatekeepers, but also talk about the mechanisms in society. Finally she will give some concrete ideas and suggestions to how to work with this going forward.
