What we have done so far



- AEC and MO started working on the EASY MO in January 2023
- set up the basic workflow and application forms in the system, data imported from Dreamapply
- connection with EWP established in the Summer
- 109 Pilot Internal Institutions joined the pilot
- First Online Trainings for users on 6th and 27th June (recordings available) and in-presence workshop at IRC Meeting in Leuven on 20th September
- First written guidelines on the basic functionalities produced in the Summer
- Now ready to test and go live for applications for 2024/25 mobilities



What EASY MO can do

- It's online: no software installation needed!
- For the moment: focus on Student Mobility for Studies
- Any programme: Erasmus, Nordplus, other Bilateral programmes
- Any artistic disciplines: Music, Dance, Theatre, Visual Arts, etc.
- Handling of LAs and IIAs with EWP Connection
- Central developments by AEC but full customisation possible by each institution

HARMA HUB – Music Theory Project

European landscape of teaching practices and pedagogical innovation in HMEI's - Music theory fields

This project created by Salvatore Gioveni promotes cross-border collaboration in the field of Music Theory through sharing knowledge and transferring pedagogical innovation. It thus responds to a lack of centralised source and framework to deepen reflection by means of cross-disciplinary study at European and international level. There is a significant wealth of educational practices from one country to another in this sector, especially in terms of harmonic musical notation and analysis. However, Music HEIs are facing the nonexistence of a European network for pedagogical staff in Music Theory so far. To improve the situation, the project will among other things develop several *intellectual outputs* and *activities* to reach results in line with the project's objectives. We plan to particularly work on innovation in the area of music theory by:

- ✓ Develop an online HUB platform for music theorists (Bruxelles)
- ✓ Develop a dynamic EU bibliography in Music Theory (Poland)
- ✓ Develop a Catalogue of music analysis (Poland)
- ✓ Develop a Multi Language terminology dictionary in Music Theory (Bruxelles)
- ✓ Create a Peer Journal for Music theorists (Tallinn)
- ✓ HarMA Week: intensive training week for staff in Tallinn
- ✓ HarMA Week: intensive training week for students in Budapest
- ✓ 1 dissemination conference and 1 final conference
- ✓ International HarMA Seminar (Harmony and Music Analysis Seminar) in Valencia, April 2025
