REPORT AT 2024, AUGUST, ON 18th



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THE PROJECT

In February 1624, the genre-representative madrigal **Combattimento di Tancredi e Clorinda** by Claudio Monteverdi (1567-1643) was performed for the first time in Venice, at Mocenigo Palace, during carnival. It's a composition that marked the history of Western music.

The aim of the project is to worthily celebrate this important musical and cultural anniversary in Abruzzo, giving space to creativity, the peculiarities of the institutions and the professionalism of the participants, networking them across the regional territory.

There are three main guidelines, considered essential for the success of the project:

- the artistic-musical approach (installations and concerts)
- the didactic approach (workshops and other forms of scholastic, professional and university musical training)
- the dissemination approach (seminars, meetings, workshops, exhibitions)

The project is, therefore, not a "simple" artistic-musical revival - albeit important - of the **Combattimento**; but rather a real 360° observatory, modular and adaptable to the needs of the participating bodies and institutes. The celebration and study of **Combattimento** in all its facets thus becomes an *escamotage* for its conscious reacquisition, within the context of a more specific Abruzzo cultural identity.

The project avails itself, at a regional level, of the patronage and collaboration of the highest institutional and professional bodies, as well as a series of figures operating in the musical and cultural, as well as educational fields, identified as essential to the success of the initiative.

The connection with middle/high schools is very important, especially if they are musical and danceoriented: because the new generations absolutely need to know, to the best of our ability, Monteverdi and music of the first Italian Seventeenth century.



THE COMBATTIMENTO IN SUMMARY

The Combattimento di Tancredi e Clorinda is a vocal-instrumental composition, a madrigal written in representative genre by Claudio Monteverdi (1567-1643) and published in the *Eighth Book of Madrigals* (Venice, Vincenti, 1638). The subtitle, *Madrigali Guerrieri et Amorosi*, indicates the structure in itself: in two symmetrical halves, one having as its subject war, the other love. After an initial scene for six voices and a series of madrigals, the two parts conclude, respectively, with the Combattimento and with another famous monteverdian page, Il Ballo delle Ingrate. The book is in fact the programmatic declaration of the three musical styles that Monteverdi has as aesthetic reference: *temperato*, *molle* and *concitato*. If the first two had already been used by previous composers, the third, the *concitato*, is an original achievement of the Cremonese musician.

The **Combattimento** (catalogue SV 153) refers to the literary masterpiece by Torquato Tasso (1544-1595), the *Gerusalemme liberata* chant XII, and performed for the first time at Venice, Mocenigo Palace, during the 1624 carnival. The composition illustrates the story of the Christian knight **Tancredi**, in love with the Muslim warrior **Clorinda**, who kills her during a duel, ignoring her identity. Following the discovery, on the point of death, Clorinda, baptized by Tancredi, dies in the arms of her lover, converted to Christianity.

The composition is truly a *unicum* in the history of Western music up to that period, well summarized, as **Claudio Gallico** points out, by the definition of representative madrigal.

«The representative attribute has two meanings, objectively it belongs to the musical and vocal style of the stage action, that is, outside the scene, it is suitable for that sound modeling, which accompanies the speech with precise coherence of structures, welcoming and exalting the symbols and the affectionate movements of words».



ETHICAL AND SOCIAL-CULTURAL VALUE OF *COMBATTIMENTO* IN TODAYS' SOCIETY

Since its modern rediscovery, around the last decade of the 19th Century, monteverdian **Combattimento** has always met with extraordinary success among the public and critics, going through quite a few significant phases of recovery of its components, both musical and aesthetic, starting with the meritorious work conducted by **Gian Francesco Malipiero** (1882-1973).

Religious conflicts, the theme of war and the struggle between different civilizations appear to be extremely modern and current themes even in the eyes of 21st Century society. It turns out that in fact this musical work, together with the intrinsic literary value of Tasso, is also of particular interest for the current public, starting with school-age adolescents. And probably, even today we can agree with the words of Monteverdi himself reported in the preface to the work the public's reaction:

«It gave applause for being a song of a genre no longer seen or heard» (preface of the Combattimento)

TIMETABLE

Given the multiplicity of interested parties, and their different location and structuring (different academic and school programming, artistic-musical programming), the project is envisaged in two distinct phases:

- <u>2023</u>, from June, on 15th, to <u>December</u>, on 31st, with a series of seminar, information, exhibition and generally preparatory activities for the creation of versions of the **Combattimento** itself. This phase will naturally also be useful for perfecting the following one.
- <u>2024</u>, from January, on 1st, to <u>December</u>, on <u>31st</u>, with a structured program of musical installations and events that will cover the entire calendar year, favoring replicas of the same in the regional territory.

SOME OF THE PLANNED ACTIVITIES

COMPOSITION LABORATORY

Composition competition on Tasso's text from *Gerusalemme liberata* and its elaboration by Claudio Monteverdi as a starting point for new compositions. The first works will be published in print and performed for the first time. With Composition Courses of Pescara, L'Aquila and Teramo Conservatories of Music.

TRAINING COURSES FOR SCHOOLS

Exhibitions - Seminars - Guided listening sessions - Individual and group work by students. For the artistic and musical high schools of L'Aquila, Pescara, Vasto (Chieti), Teramo, as well as the secondary schools of the four provinces.

TASSO AND MONTEVERDI IN THE COMBATTIMENTO

A particular section of studies and research is dedicated to the complex relationship between Monteverdi and the *Gerusalemme liberata*.

EARLY MUSIC MASTERCLASSES AND WORKSHOPS (PROFESSIONAL LEVEL)

For Conservatories and Universities musical students, in support of specialist study courses (performative and musicological). Concerts, stage productions and original publications are planned.

FROM THE ART OF WAR TO DANCE INTERPRETATION

Dance and the **Combattimento**, from the military genesis of the duel form to its transposition into pantomime and modern choreography.

THE MONTEVERDI'S CITIES

Educational courses in the places of Claudio Monteverdi. Guided visits to palaces, study centers, theatres, libraries and archives connected to the birth of **Combattimento** (Cremona, Mantua, Venice, Bologna, Rome).

EXHIBITION ROUTES

Panels, books, photos, videos, audio, *mirabilia* and other documents and historical artefacts relating to the themes of the evolution of musical instruments between the late Sixteenth and early Seventeenth centuries, Claudio Monteverdi, the genesis of the **Combattimento**.

SETTINGS AND CONCERTS

Monteverdi's opera revived on stage, both in the rigorous philological-musical reconstruction of the time and in the adaptations of some important composers of the twentieth century (Torchi, Toni, Malipiero, Ghedini, Berio and others). Repeats are expected in the main regional concert seasons.

MONTEVERDIAN CONVERSATIONS

Interviews, courses and seminars with renowned musicologists, musicians, researchers and scholars of Monteverdi's opera, both in person and online.

DIGITAL PRODUCTIONS - DOCUMENTS

Video clips, docu-films, audio recordings.

Indexed digital database (twins HD 2 Tb) of all the material collected and created relating to the Monteverdi **Combattimento**, from 1624 to today. Monographic essay relating to the activities carried out.

AND ... AFTER 2024?

A PROPOSAL FOR A REDISCOVERED *COMBATTIMENTO* "SEQUEL", NATIONAL (2025) AND EUROPEAN (2025-2026) LEVELS.

1624-2024: 4 CENTURIES OF FIGHT AND BEYOND

With the date of 2024, December, on 31st, the first celebratory project on Monteverdi's *Combattimento* in Abruzzo will end.

Its aim of was, above all, to bring the main regional musical institutions into collaboration, to create in synergy across the regional territory a whole series of musical and cultural initiatives on Monteverdi's *Combattimento*.

What I certainly couldn't imagine, in 2023 on March, at the birth of this project, that I would become aware of much more material related to *Combattimento* than I thought. Not only in Italy, but also in France, England, Deutschland, Poland, Serbia, and so many countries, also in USA and Australia. And not only in the specific musical sector, but also in many other areas, some apparently very far from Monteverdi's composition.

Not just literature, with important references and reworkings in the main European languages: France, England, Deutschland. But also, an extraordinary series of testimonies in the history of art (iconography of music, in particular), dance (classical and modern), and in general all the performing arts, including historical and modern means of communication (radio, discography, theatral productions, videos, television, cinema, digital web): many of which, although relatively recent, whose collective memory is already largely lost. Because, as strange as it may seem, it's much easier to find original surviving testimonies from Monteverdi's time than material relating to the perception of *Combattimento* between the second half of the 19th and all the 20th centuries.

Current society finds it more difficult than ancient ones to preserve its historical and therefore musical memory, its cultural heritage. Perhaps, our task, as Conservatory of Music teachers, is not only to rediscover the remote past, but also to preserve and pass the near past, together to the ancient testimonies, to the new generations. And in this vision, the *Combattimento* is not just a precious Italian musical resource, but rather a cultural heritage that is at least European, maybe Western.

I therefore hope that this report can attract the attention of Colleagues from other European music Conservatories, to collaborate in safeguarding this important musical and cultural heritage.
