Assignment

Guest professors main subject instrumental/vocal studies offer individual instrument lessons within Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes in music, providing strong continuity with weekly contact moments. They build a positive dynamic within their class and actively seek collegial cooperation with other professors. They are responsible for the training of creative and entrepreneurial musicians, guiding them in the realisation of their artistic projects.

Profile

The candidate:

- is active as a performing musician on national and/or international podia
- has a wide experience as a violinist (with attention for tradition and innovation)
- has extensive experience as a chamber musician
- preferably also has professional experience as an orchestral musician
- lives or works in Belgium or is prepared to live and work in Belgium
- knows how to link his artistry to pedagogical skills, being inspired and paying attention to the student's self-development
- has a clear vision and plan of approach regarding student recruitment
- preferably has teaching experience in higher music education in one or more of the following areas: main subject violin, chamber music
- is a team player and consequently willing to cooperate with colleagues
- is flexible, engaged and active
- has experience with or is receptive for cross-disciplinary cooperation
- is willing to stimulate research towards students
- preferably has a strong connection to part-time arts education (DKO) and/or art secondary arts education (KSO) in Flanders
- is willing to encourage students to upgrade their digital skills

- can communicate in English and/or Dutch
- Is loyal towards the assignment, mission, vision and educational policy of the school

Procedure

This file includes:

- a motivation letter and curriculum vitae
- a note concerning the personal artistic-pedagogical vision (max. 2 pages)
- a link to an (online) artistic portfolio with video files of performances (min. 20 minutes)
- optional: a maximum of 2 recommendation letters (please mention coordinates/contact data)

A first selection will be performed by a screening commission, consisting of the head of music, internal and external experts in the field and an HR member as a reporter.

Afterwards the candidates who are selected will be invited for an interview. This interview will also focus on the artistic portfolio.

The screening commission works out a motivated report on the result of the screening and communicates a ranking of the candidates.

On the basis of this report, the head of music will investigate the possibilities of a potential employment and will have the necessary conversations. If a candidate is employed (in case of a minimum of 3 students which can be regularly financed) he will get an appointment for minimum 20% as a contractual guest professor, from 1/11/2023. The extent of the assignment and the salary will be determined by the head of music and will depend on the amount of students.
