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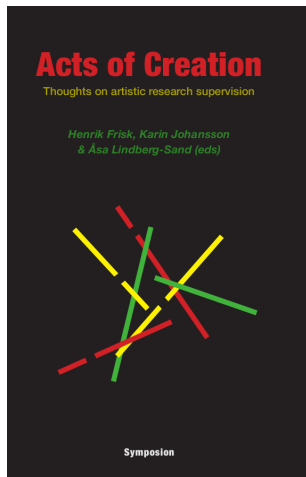

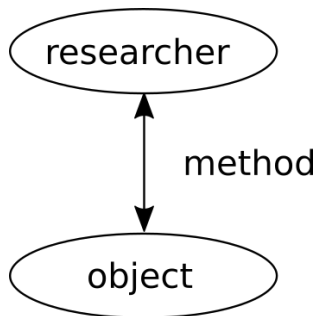
Artistic method

Method in artistic research may be seen as the means with which the sensibility to the artistic process may be organised in the research activity.

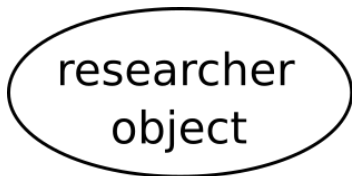
